
# How to set up Access in dbTPRM / Coupa

### Set up Access to Coupa / dbTPRM



You will receive two emails; one containing your **link to Coupa**, another containing the authentication code to set up the access. This occurs only once when your account is created.

#### Click the 'Link' on the email.



Click 'Continue'.




Populate 'New Password' and 'Confirm New Password'.

Click 'Continue'.










If Deutsche Bank requires attestation or evidence of controls, you receive an email to fill in CAQs.

Click the link to 'R.Portal' on the email.

As Control Assessments are carried out typically for Risk Types, you will get an email for different Risk Types, if your responds to different Risk Types is required.






Then you need to enter your login credential that were set up in the previous steps.


Click 'Sign In'.





Click 'Accept'.





Now, the CAQ is displayed for you.

In case you want to delegate the CAQ, please see the following slide.

Otherwise; please fill in the relevant information.


If you want to add a comment to your answer, you can use the button under Actions.

At the end of population, click 'Submit'.

After submission, the questionnaire will be sent to Deutsche Bank for review.

Please note: In the event that Deutsche Bank require more information, or clarification, you will be contacted with details of that request.





If the person isn't listed as additional contact yet, you won't find him/her in the drop down and need to set up that contact by cklicking the **Plus** button.


When you create an additional contact, they are by default set as 'Active'. The tool will send two notifications to the new contact with subjects: "A Coupa Risk Assess account has been created for you", "Your Coupa Risk Assess authentication code". Using these emails the user can gain access to dbTPRM.

The primary contact can now use the delegate option to search for the new contacts and delegate the CAQ.

Once delegated, the questionnaire disappears from primary user's home page and will now appear in the new contacts home page.








To log in to Coupa / dbTPRM you can either use the Link that is provided in a notification email or the general Link that was provided with the first email.

It might be of advantage to save the Link in your Favorites.






This is your Dashboard view, where you can see open **Evaluations** / Questionnaires as well as open **Action Plans** to mitigate Gaps in the Risk Assessment.

By clicking **Show Me All** the list of open items will be shown.






Apart from different Risk Domains, you will find two different types of Control Assessment Questionnaires within your queue:

- 1. Control Assessment Questionnaire [Risk Type] Third Party
- 2. Control Assessment Questionnaire [Risk Type] Transaction

Transaction based CAQs are relevant for one particular engagement while Third Party CAQs are general questionnaires for one particular Supplier that only need to be answered when the first Engagement for that Supplier is created in dbTPRM\*.

<sup>\*</sup> It might be necessary to re-run a CAQ after a year in case of expiring policies for example.





Context shows you the name of the Engagement and your Company as Candidate Supplier in brackets.

So, if you get an email notificaction from Coupa or an employee from Deutsche Bank reaches out to you on an Engagement, you will find this to help you filter for the correct Engagement.

As Third Party CAQs are independently from specific Engagement, you will find them by filtering for your Company name (last row in screenshot).

#### **Status**

- Rejected: The Risk Type Controller at DB has reviewed your responses in the CAQ and requires additional
  information. They will provide a detailed description which you can see at the top of the questionnaire.
- · In Process: You saved your progress, but didn't submit the CAQ.
- Not Started: Nothing was done or saved for this CAQ yet.
